FMC Community Empowerment Board to Review Community Plan

Members of the FMC Community Empowerment board will meet in regular session Monday, November 10, beginning at 6:30 p.m. Board chair Bob Marreel from Osage will call the meeting to order in the General Assembly Room of the Floyd County Courthouse, ground floor.

Agenda items will include a review of the September 15 board minutes and a financial report from Gloria Carr, fiscal agent. The primary focus of the meeting will be a board review and progress report of the Empowerment organization's 3-year community plan. Don Chaplain from UNI will facilitate the first of two review sessions, which will include the initial two objectives in the FMC Empowerment Community Plan, "Healthy Children" and "Children Ready to Succeed in School". The plan was approved by the state in 2007 and is effective through 2010.
